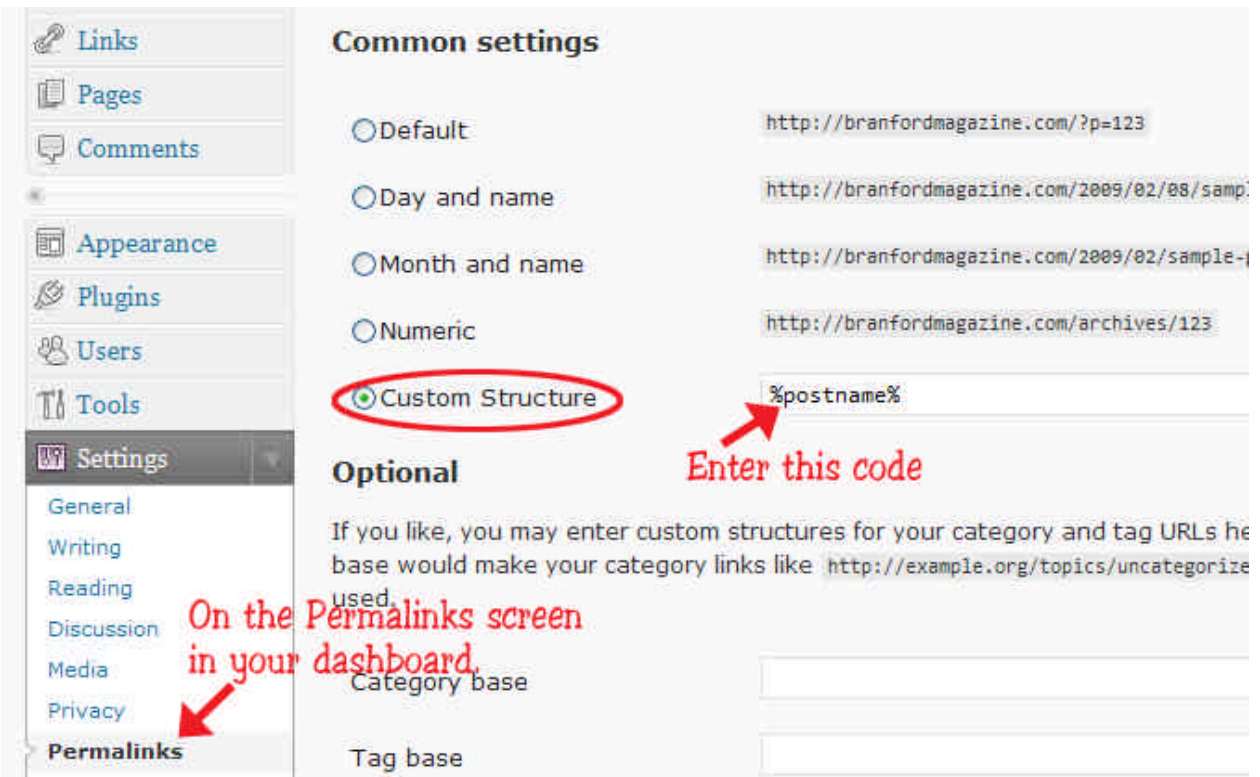


In that form area, enter this code: **%postname%**

It will look like the following screenshot.



Then, save those changes by clicking on "Save Changes" at the foot of that page.

That's it! You now have nicer URLs.

Note: If your WordPress screen tells you that you need a file called `.htaccess`, you'll need to create one. It's easy.

I show you exactly what to do in the Appendix of this book, in the section called **Creating a `.htaccess` file.**

After you upload that, you may need to be sure that it's writable. Ask your hosting service for their recommendations. They may suggest `CHMOD 0777`.

I talk about this kind of issue in the **Troubleshooting** section at the back of this book, in the section about FTP issues and images.
